

Articulation Agreement between Three Rivers College and Southeast Missouri State University

A.S. Nursing to B.S.N. (Online)

This document specifies the terms for a transfer agreement between Southeast Missouri State University (hereinafter referred to as "Southeast") and Three Rivers College (hereinafter referred to as "TRC") and is intended to benefit students at both institutions. This articulation agreement will lead to the awarding of college credit in the BSN program by Southeast for courses successfully completed by students at TRC.

This articulation agreement is intended to prepare TRC students completing the Associate of Science in Nursing degree for Southeast's online RN-BSN program. Southeast's program is offered solely online.

TRC and Southeast view this agreement as consistent with the Missouri Coordinating Board for Higher Education guidelines advocating cooperative and seamless transfer arrangements between two-year and baccalaureate institutions.

To ensure the TRC student is ready to enroll in Southeast's RN-BSN program, the student must follow the attached program of study. TRC and Southeast will inform each other of curriculum changes that impact this agreement.

This agreement will become effective with the 2017-18 academic year.
