The Financial Aid Shopping Sheet is a consumer tool that is designed to simplify information that prospective students receive about costs and financial aid so that they can make informed decisions about which postsecondary institution to attend.

Once a student has completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and has been packaged with federal financial aid benefits the award notification and the Shopping Sheet will be available online through the portal. **The Shopping Sheet is not an official award notification.** To accept and decline financial aid awards you must access your online award notification.
