


FACULTY/STAFF INSTRUCTIONS FOR UPDATING AND ADDING SE ALERTS CONTACT INFORMATION


The SE Alerts emergency notification system will be used to keep you informed during

The University places a high priority on communicating emergency information. By providing this information, employees are ensuring the most current and correct information is on file for use.


1. Log in to portal.semo.edu.



2. Select the 'Employee SS' tab.




3. Select the 'Update Emergency Notification Phone Numbers' link in the Personal Information box.



4. Verify the current mobile number the University has on file to send you SE Alerts text messages. SE Alerts do not impose a separate charge for text messages, however your mobile carrier's message and data rates may apply depending on the terms and conditions of your mobile phone contract. Please contact your mobile service provider about such charges.



5. If this number is incorrect, or you prefer to receive SE Alerts text messages on a different mobile phone, input a new number in the 'Override Number to text section.'



6. SE Alerts will always be sent to your Southeast email address (sekey@semo.edu). You may also designate up to four additional email addresses to receives SE Alerts. These can include a personal email address or the email address of a spouse, parent, guardian or family members. To ensure these personal addresses receive SE Alerts emails, it is recommended to add sealerts@newlist.semo.edu to your safe sender or contact list.
