



EIBI Service Description ***June 2009***

Assessment = 12-18 hours/48-72 units

- Assessment time may increase as level of functioning increases
- Developmental History
- Natural Observation (home, school, or other familiar setting)
- Skills Assessment
- Behavioral Assessment (if there are issues present)
- Results in *Assessment Report* (includes findings, recommendations, and objectives)
- * Assessment does NOT include a diagnostic assessment

Initial Training = 20 hours/80 units

- Typically 6 hours per day x 3 days
- EIBI staff train family and intervention team members in initial intervention strategies
- Results in *Initial Consult Report*

Ongoing Training = 6-8 hours/24-32 units per month, as needed

- EIBI staff train new intervention team members in intervention strategies

Ongoing Support = 6-8 hours/24-32 units per month

- 30-60 minute phone conversations with family and team members
- 3-4 hour monthly consults with family and team members
- Review intervention data and anecdotal observations
- Evaluate and revise intervention strategies
- Prepare teaching and training materials, objectives
- Results in *Teleconsult Notes* and *Follow-Up Consult Reports/Notes*

Services Continue Until

- Service limits are reached
- Children no longer require services
- Children are no longer progressing
