## **Call for Exhibition Proposals:**

The Rosemary Berkel and Harry L. Crisp II Museum is currently accepting exhibition proposals from artists and curators for the Greene Gallery and the Transition Spaces Series. Students currently enrolled in an undergraduate art program are not eligible.

## **Greene Gallery:**

Solo or Group exhibitions are welcomed in our Greene Gallery and open to regional, national, and international artists.

## **Transition Spaces Series:**

Artists living within 150 miles radius of Cape Girardeau are invited to exhibit and discuss their work in connection with a current exhibition at the Crisp Museum.

Artists submit the following:

- 1) 20 images of work to be exhibited on CD/DVD (image size should not be larger than 1 MB)
  - include 2 different views for 3-D works
  - video works should not be longer than 2 minutes in length
  - include contact info on CD/DVD
- 2) Detailed list of images submitted (size, title, date, medium)
- 3) CV/resume
- 4) Artist Statement
- 5) Supporting materials (press releases, articles, reviews, etc.)
- 6) SASE if you wish your materials to be returned

Curators submit all of the above plus the following:

- 1) 20 images of work to be exhibited for all participating artists on CD/DVD (image size should not be larger than 1 MB)
  - include 2 different views for 3-D works
  - video works should not be longer than 2 minutes in length
  - include contact info on CD/DVD
- 2) Curator CV/resume and statement of proposal
