OPTION 1	*22 ACT 2.5 GPA **C-BASE all passed with 235 on each section ##Course requirements listed below
OPTION 2	2.5 GPA **C-BASE all passed with 265 on each section ##Course requirements listed below
OPTION 3	3.0 GPA **C-BASE all passed with 235 on each section ##Course requirements listed below

##Course Requirements for all 3 options include:

- Must have 57 hours completed
- EN140 completed with a grade of "C" or above
- Block I completed with a written recommendation (EL120 or ED250 for elementary)
(ED250 or ED251 and PY222 for secondary)

*An ACT before 10/1/89 permits a minimum score of 20. A score of 265 or higher on all sections of the C-BASE will permit any ACT/SAT score to be accepted. Contact an advisor for required SAT scores. Any previous 4 year degree from an accredited institution will wave the ACT.

**The C-BASE tests include English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Writing. All sections must be passed within 2 years of the semester in which the student passed any section or all previously passed sections are void. If C-BASE is taken at a testing site other than Southeast, code it to be sent to Southeast (00250). Any previous 4 year degree from an accredited institution will wave the C-BASE.
