St. Louis Community College students who plan to transfer and complete the approved 42 Hour General Education requirements will have "Missouri General Education requirements" certification noted on their transcripts. This certification satisfies all lower division General Education requirements for Missouri public colleges and universities.

The Southeast Missouri State University Bachelor of General Studies (BGS) degree allows individual structuring of a degree program without requiring major or minor fields. The BGS Online allows St. Louis Community College students to continue their education and complete a Bachelor degree at Southeast Missouri State University by taking all classes and meeting all program requirements over the Internet.

The BGS program is designed to give students maximum flexibility while earning their degree. Students can build a degree with their own emphasis, and unlike a traditional major, the BGS program allows students to switch from another area of study with a minimum amount of additional course work. Admission Requirements

- Students who have completed an Associate in Arts degree, the 42 Hour General Education Block, or who have earned at least 45 transferable credit hours with a cumulative 2.0 GPA qualify for admission.

- Submit transcripts from all previous colleges and universities attended. (Transcripts can be faxed as long as they are deemed official copies from the sending institution.)
- Submit a one-time application fee of \$25.

Students must:

- 1) Complete 9 semester hours of upper level University Studies interdisciplinary courses in addition to the 42 Hour General Education Block/AA completion.
- 2) Complete at least 30 hours through Southeast; 12 of the final 18 hours towards the degree must be through Southeast.
- 3) Achieve a cumulative GPA of 2.0 as well as a Southeast GPA of at least 2.0
- 4) Complete 30 hours of senior level courses (300-599 from four year institutions) – changes to 39 hours with the Fall 2008 catalog
- 5) Achieve a passing score on the WP003 Writing Proficiency Exam.
- 6) Complete the California Critical Thinking Exam.
- 7) For students with a catalog year of Fall 2005 or later, complete a series of career proficiencies (CL001 – CL004).
