MOVE IN SCHEDULE

Welcome to summer housing! Southeast Missouri State University is very pleased to have you as part of our campus community. Move-in begins **Sunday**, at **12:00 p.m.** for all sessions. All check-ins take place at the Towers Customer Service Desk. The Towers desk will be open until **6:00 p.m.** for key pick up. Students arriving outside the designated check-in times should contact the Hall Director to arrange a time to move in.

You will receive your housing assignment information via email. You can verify your housing assignment from the housing portal link "**Assignment Info**".

Assignment Information

Instructions on how to check your housing assignment:

1. Log into your Southeast student portal
2. Select the "Student SS" tab
3. Scroll down to locate the "Residence Life" channel
4. Select the "Residence Life Housing Portal" link
5. Select "Residence Life Housing Portal" once again
6. Select "New" or "Current/Returning Students"
7. Select "Assignment Info" to view your housing assignment

- Ethernet Cord
- Shower Shoes
- Waste Basket
- Cleaning Supplies
- Umbrella/Rain boots
- First Aid Kit
- Snack Food
- Dishes, Bowls, Silverware
- Can Opener
- Cards/Board Games
- Microwave (No more than 800 watts & surge protector UL Approved)
- Refrigerator (No greater than 3.2 cubic feet)

Cable and internet are two things you will want to set up after you move into your room. You must supply a television and coaxial cable cord to view cable channels. All televisions must be equipped with a digital "QAM" or "Clear QAM" tuner. To access campus internet, you will need to register all electronic devices that need Wi-Fi. PARKING/MAIL & DESK SERVICES/ MEAL PLAN

Parking

When you arrive, you should check-in at the Towers Desk to get your room keys. You can park your vehicle in the parking lots adjacent to the circle or in the large lot and unload your vehicle. When parking or unloading your vehicle, do not park in any reserved parking spaces. After unloading you must register your vehicle with the department of public safety. Towers Resident parking lot (located near Group Housing) is available except for reserved and metered parking spaces.

Mail Delivery
