Scholarship Agreement**

The following guidelines have been accepted by the members of the Jacksonian Charter Chapter of the American Business Women’s Association (ABWA). After reading guidelines, please sign and date this agreement and include it with your submitted scholarship application. Failure to submit this signed agreement may result in your application being denied.

1. Scholarship checks shall be made payable to both the scholarship recipient and the education institution together.
2. Scholarship recipients shall be notified by mail of the award amount.
3. All money received by a scholarship recipient shall be applied to books, fees, or tuition.
4. Annual scholarship amounts shall be determined by funds available and approved by the general membership at a regular meeting.
5. If after consideration of all money (grants, loans, scholarships) offered a potential recipient, the ABWA award exceeds the student’s charges, the remaining money shall be offered to the next recipient in line or be extended to the next semester for the same student.
6. All applicants shall be required to sign an agreement with the ABWA organization stating terms of the award to show acceptance of such terms.
7. Scholarships offered by the Jacksonian Charter Chapter of ABWA are for a one time issuance only and not automatically renewable.
8. The following criteria shall be followed when applying for scholarship money:
 - a. The scholarship application must be filled out in its entirety along with the scholarship contract.
 - b. The applicant must include three (3) character reference letters.
 - c. The applicant must include a copy of the transcript of courses completed.
 - d. The applicant must maintain a 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
 - e. A biographical statement must be included, listing educational background, financial need, and pertinent personal information.
 - f. The applicant must be a resident of Cape Girardeau County.
