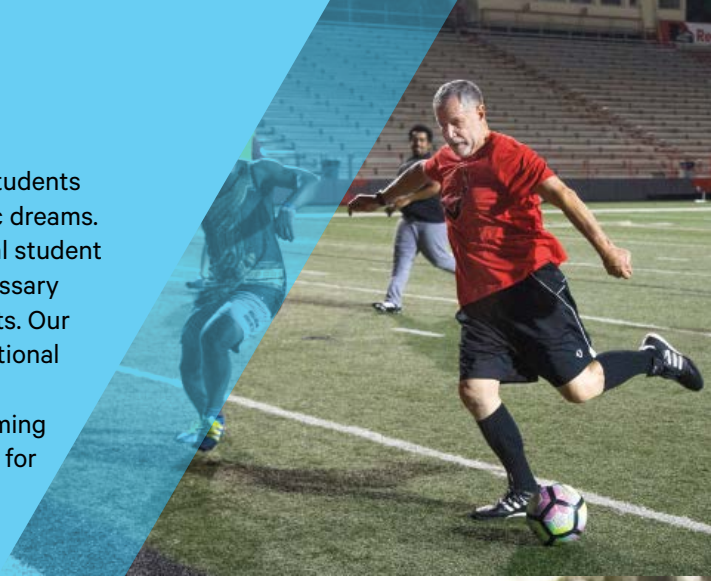

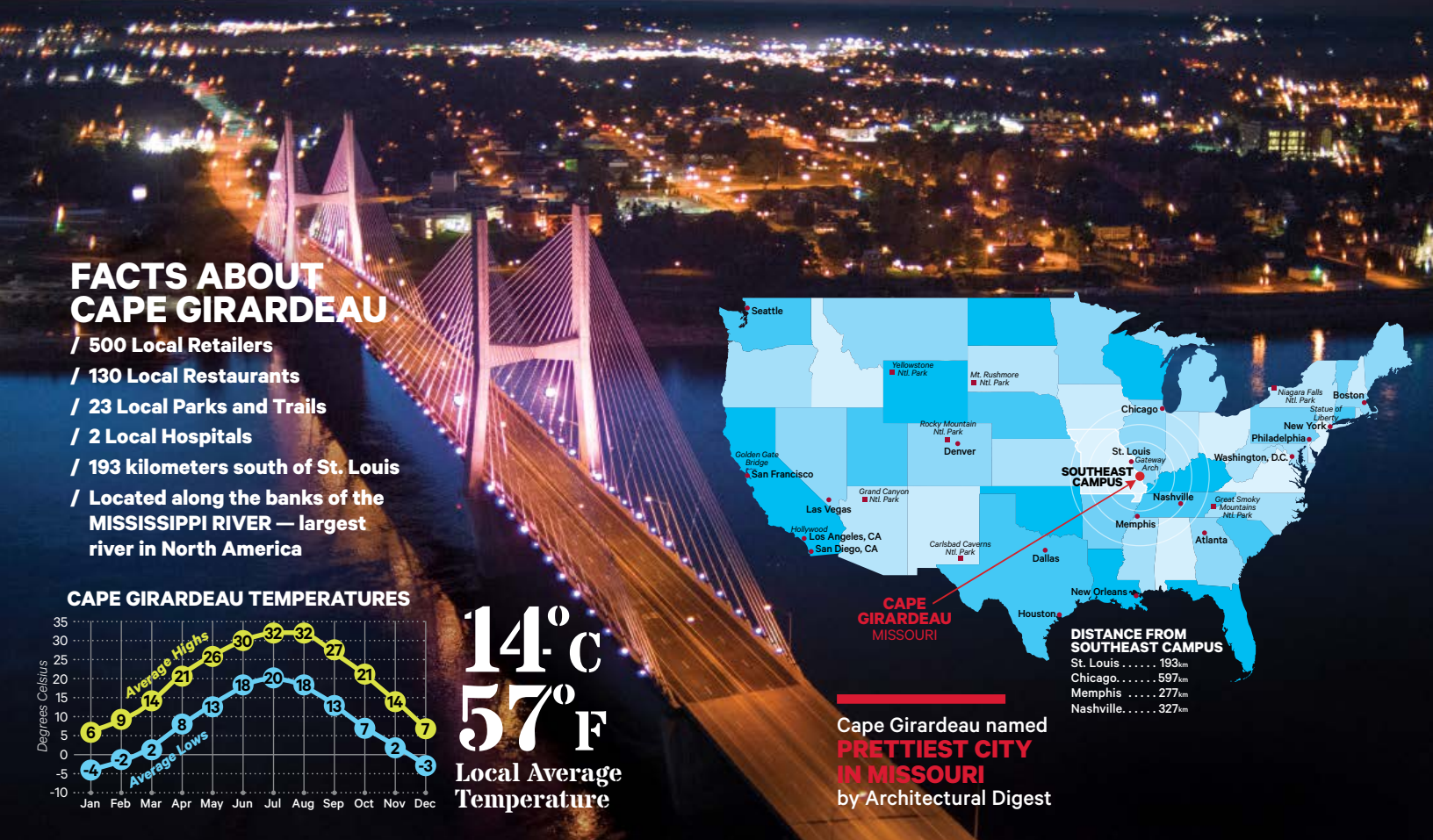

SAFE AND WELCOMING COMMUNITY

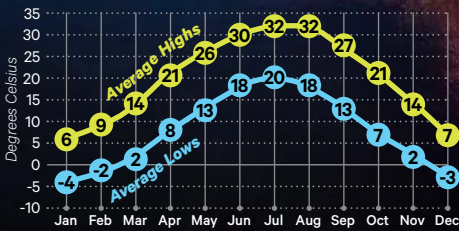

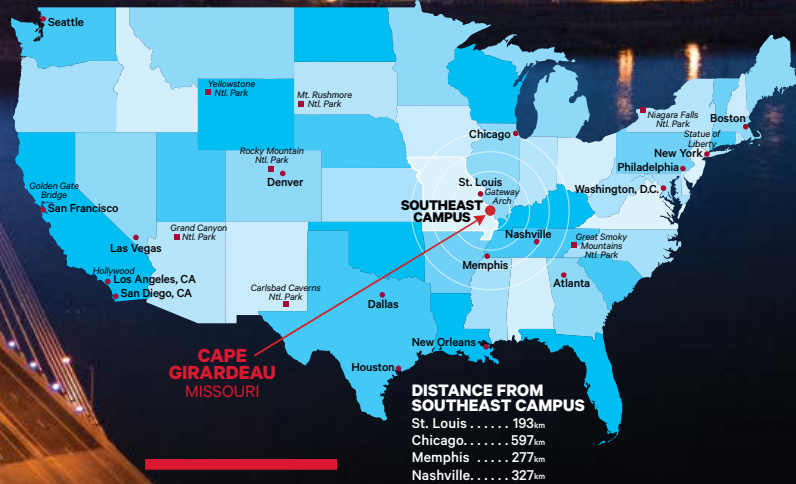
