

What to Wear?

Commencement will be **Saturday, May 16, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. in the Show Me Center.** Students assemble on the track in the Student Recreation Center no later than 45 minutes prior to the start of their ceremony.

What you wear with your cap and gown?

The following honor emblems are listed in the program:

- Red tassel: Provided with cap and gown for students who earn honors in associate degrees, cum laude, magna cum laude or summa cum laude.
- Engraved medallion: Provided with cap and gown for students who earn Academic Distinction in the Department of the Major
- Engraved medallion: see Dr. McGill or Ashley Showalter at the Honors House, for Jane Stephens Honors Program completers
- Red, white and blue cord: provided with cap and gown, for members of U.S. military and veterans
- Red, white and blue stole: provided with cap and gown, for members of U.S. military and veterans (who chose to order and pay for it)
