A. MINUTES:

Motion by Cwick, seconded by Bratberg, to approve the distributed minutes from the February 7, 2017, Academic Council meeting. Unanimously approved.

B. ACTION ITEMS:

1. University Studies – Remove Upper Division UI Course Requirements:

Barrios moved and Ortiz seconded consideration of removal of upper division level course requirements. Barrios invited Wayne Bowen to provide further explanation. Discussion followed. McAllister called the vote. Motion passed unanimously.

2. Master of Science in Criminal Justice – Request for Revision:

Jenkins moved and Bratberg seconded request for revision in MS Criminal Justice. Jenkins invited Michelle Kilburn to provide further explanation. Discussion followed, and a friendly amendment was accepted as electives are chosen in such a way that 18 hours must be at the 600- credit level or above. McAllister called the vote. 3. Master of Arts in Teaching – STEM Education:

Bratberg moved and Jenkins seconded consideration of Master of Arts in Teaching: STEM Education proposal. Cwick provided further explanation. Discussion followed. McAllister called to vote. Motion passed unanimously.
